## Transfer Credit Guide BS Human Resource Management

Rather, it is a guide for you and your advisors. \* You should be aware that courses must be passed with *a grade of C or higher* in order to be considered for transfer credit. Students transferring 30 credits or more and Extended Campus students will take **ID 201**.
